Shaping the Future of Wright Brothers National Memorial

Dear Friends,

Thank you for taking the time to join us in this planning process. Your interest and vested time will help guide the future of Wright Brothers National Memorial.

Wright Brothers National Memorial (the park) commemorates the first successful power-driven airplane flight, which was made by Wilbur and Orville Wright at Kitty Hawk, North Carolina on December 17, 1903.

The National Park Service (NPS) is preparing a General Management Plan Amendment (the plan) for the park to review and modify existing strategies in the park's General Management Plan (developed in 1996). The plan will protect park resources while improving the visitor experience, sharing the story of the Wright brothers, and maintaining the important commemorative landscape. It will also address wayfinding, circulation, facilities, and landscape management.

PURPOSE OF THE PLAN

This planning process provides an opportunity to review the existing General Management Plan to consider how conditions at the park have changed and evaluate planning issues and objectives. An amended plan will provide updated guidance for management of park facilities and operations to improve visitor experience and overall park management. As an initial step in the development of the plan, the park is undertaking a civic engagement process.

KEY ISSUES

This plan is being initiated to help define strategies for the following key issues:

- The pavilion structures erected for the centennial were intended to be temporary, are located directly in the historic viewshed, and detract from the memorial landscape and setting.
- There is limited wayfinding and interpretive messaging throughout the memorial landscape.
- There are few areas suitable for education of and programming for large groups or for holding events, especially in the case of inclement weather.
- Administrative offices and storage spaces are limited.

In addition to issues, there are also opportunities to enhance visitor experiences throughout the site. For example, there are opportunities to provide shaded areas for visitors to rest, particularly during the heat of the summer. There are also opportunities for additional pedestrian walkways that encourage visitors to discover all the site has to offer.

What is a General Management Plan Amendment?

An amendment to a general management plan (GMP) is a plan for modifying actions approved in the park's existing GMP or adding new management actions to address new conditions or priorities that have changed since the GMP was approved.



DRAFT STRATEGIES

We want to hear from you! Please share your thoughts about our draft strategies to address the issues and let us know if there are other actions that we should consider.

- Improve signage along the entrance road with clear fee and wayfinding information.
- Evaluate visitor center parking to consider improved circulation and drop-off options.
- Establish facilities to serve park volunteers.
- Add a new administration building with a classroom space or a separate interpretive building. Possible locations include:
 - In the wooded area between the parking lot and Kill Devil Hill
 - In the existing partner facility south of Kill Devil Hill
- Add new pedestrian walkways along the wooded areas to provide opportunities for shade and to limit pedestrian use of the roadways.
- Add a few benches throughout the site.
- Establish a tram service that provides access to the pylon and other sites within the park.
- Selectively thin vegetation between the monument and the airstrip so visitors can better appreciate the active runway and its association with the events being memorialized.
