

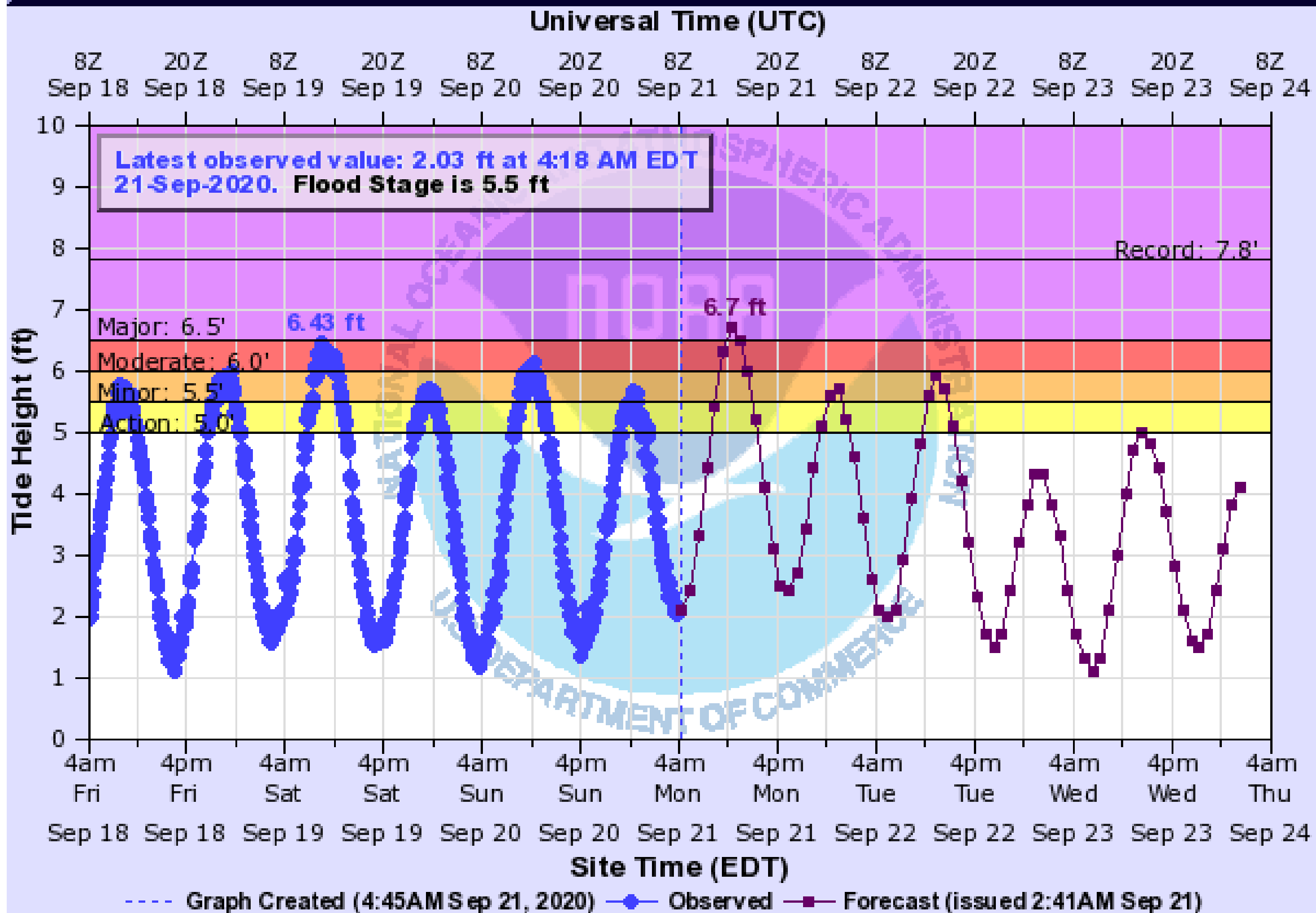

Flooding Threat Continues Into Tuesday

- The **Coastal Flood Warning** remains in effect for the Northern Outer Banks and Hatteras Island until this afternoon, but minor coastal flooding will continue for Tuesday's high tides.
- The **Coastal Flood Advisory** has been **extended** for Pamlico, S. Craven, Carteret and coastal Onslow counties as well as Ocracoke Island and Core Banks until tomorrow afternoon with minor flooding forecast at high tide. The advisory for Beaufort and Tyrrell Counties will expire tonight.
- **High Surf Advisory** is extended for beaches north of Cape Lookout until Wednesday afternoon and evening.
- Water levels peak during the high tide cycle this morning and early afternoon.
- Strong, long period swell from distant Hurricane Teddy will affect the coast through midweek, continuing the potential for significant beach erosion and dune overwash.
